FROM THE PRESIDENT AND CEO

In September 1654, 23 Jewish refugees from Brazil arrived in the Dutch colony of New Amsterdam. They found a hostile environment with Peter Stuyvesant, the governor of the colony, opposed to their presence. However, his superiors at the Dutch West India Company overruled him, allowing the refugees to stay with one condition—they must take care of their own poor, ensuring they never became a burden “to the company or the community.” This was rooted in the Talmudic principle that **“all of Israel are responsible for one another,”** marking the **beginning of Jewish philanthropy in the United States.**

Fast-forward 370 years, and this spirit of responsibility thrives within the JCF community. The fiscal year 2024 was marked by significant events, including the tragic attacks of October 7 and the ensuing hostage crisis and war. The community’s response was extraordinary, with nearly **\$35 million more in grants distributed in October 2023** than the previous October. JCF Fundholders contributed over **\$1 billion to charity, with \$148 million directed to Israeli organizations and over \$190 million supporting U.S. community organizations (like UJA) involved in aiding Israel.**

The year also witnessed rising antisemitism in the U.S., particularly on campuses. Once again, our Fundholders took decisive action, **increasing support for Hillels, Federations, and other organizations uniting the community to combat this issue.** While contributions to educational institutions continued, those institutions received fewer grants and less money.

Facilitating the profound impact of your philanthropy is both a privilege and an honor. Thank you for your trust and unwavering commitment to making a difference.

OCTOBER 7

What Changed After October 7, 2023

The October 7 attacks spurred a surge in philanthropy, with JCF donors not only increasing their overall giving, but also expanding their support to include organizations aiding Israel and combating antisemitism. 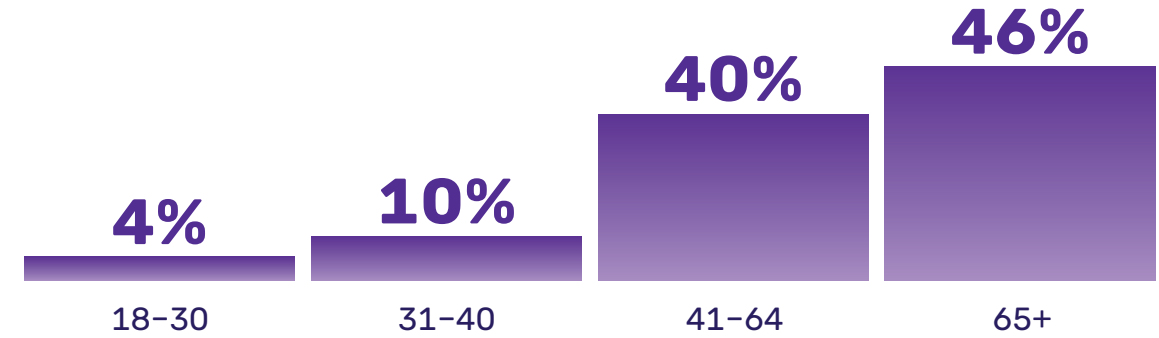

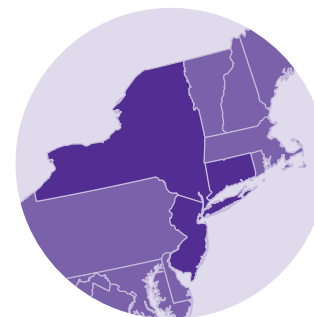

SPECIAL GIFTS FUND

\$500,000 in emergency funds to Israel after the October 7 attacks

Each year, JCF's trustees direct grants from JCF's Special Gifts Fund to pressing needs in the community. In fiscal year 2024, JCF granted over **\$2 million** to local and global organizations, including emergency funds to Israel.

JCF Fundholders also benefit from “double bottom line” returns—their fees are reinvested into the Jewish community in the form of a **\$2 million** unrestricted gift to UJA-Federation of New York’s annual campaign, as well as community gifts to Jewish organizations from JCF’s endowment, the Special Gifts Fund. JCF Fundholders have distributed **\$610 million** to UJA since 1972.

JEWISH VALUES IMPACT INVESTMENTS

JCF is committed to creating positive Jewish impact beyond grantmaking.

As such, we offer an array of impact investments that align with our mission as the largest Jewishly affiliated donor advised fund in the country. These offerings provide a distinct value-add for our Fundholders, giving them the opportunity to maximize their impact with their investments, in addition to their active grantmaking. They enhance the ESG and socially responsible investment options already on our platform.



Diane and Michael Werner, longtime Fundholders with Jewish Communal Fund, have amplified their philanthropy through impact investing.

Rather than using traditional investments, they leverage JCF's impact investing options to put their charitable dollars to immediate use. By investing in organizations like Ogen and Hebrew Free Loan Society (HFLS), which provide interest-free loans to those in need, the Werners maintain a reserve for future giving while making a direct, positive impact.

Since 2018, HFLS has received over \$4.3 million in interest-free loans from JCF donors, enabling over \$5.2 million in loans to 660 borrowers across New York City, Long Island, and Westchester. These loans have empowered students, families, and entrepreneurs, all with a 99% repayment rate. The Werners believe the returns from social impact loans are as meaningful as traditional investments, viewing financial empowerment as central to their giving strategy.

Adam Chill, a longtime JCF Fundholder, leveraged the flexibility and personalized service of his donor advised fund to make a significant impact on his community.

When founding The Bayit Association to create Sabbath observant, kosher housing for adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities in northern New Jersey, Adam worked closely with JCF to donate complex assets, including illiquid securities from a private company that went public. This strategy enabled him to make a substantial contribution to fund The Bayit Association's mission, demonstrating how JCF empowers Fundholders to turn ambitious philanthropic visions into reality, even when dealing with complex financial situations.

"There's a lot of flexibility in the JCF format. Being able to pick up the phone and say, 'Hey, I want to do this. Can we figure it out?' versus dealing with a large, impersonal organization makes a huge difference."

The Anita K. Hersh Philanthropic Fund exemplifies a different approach to legacy planning, where a donor entrusts their charitable fund to friends rather than family members.

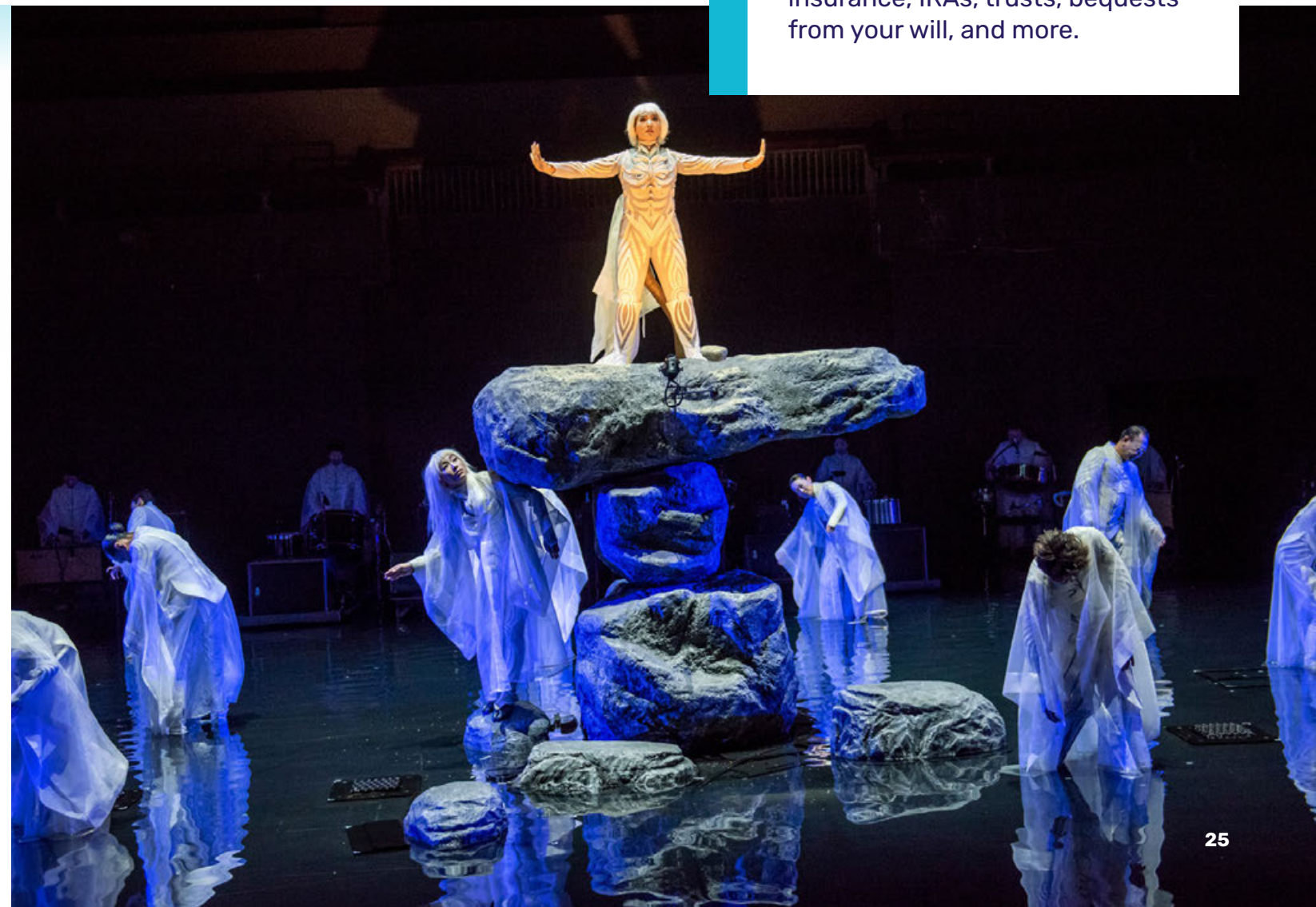

This arrangement ensures that Anita's core values and philanthropic interests, particularly in supporting the arts, Holocaust education, and the elderly, continue to be honored.

Their experience highlights the power of thoughtful legacy planning and demonstrates how entrusting a charitable fund to friends who share one's values can ensure a lasting philanthropic impact.
